The Family will:

Curriculum & Homework

- ✓ Support their child with homework and other opportunities for home learning.
- ✓ Attend open evenings, held each term, to discuss their child's progress.
- ✓ When possible attend their own child's assembly.



Attendance & Punctuality

- ✓ Ensure that their child attends regularly.
- ✓ Contact the school by phone on the first morning of absence.
- ✓ Provide a note of explanation when the child returns to school if the child has been absent for 4 or more days.
- ✓ Not take holidays during term time .
- ✓ Complete a leave request form for all non-sickness and medical appointment absences
- ✓ Ensure that their child arrives on time at **8:55am** and is collected at the end of the day at **3:15pm**.
- ✓ Nursery times, Morning (8:45am - 11:45am)
Afternoon (12:30pm - 3:30pm)



Safeguarding

- ✓ Let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect their child's work/behaviour including bullying.
- ✓ Not stop or park on the zigzag lines or in the middle of the road outside the school or on any other non parking designated area.

Support

- ✓ When possible support the Southfield Parent Staff Association (SPSA) Activities.
- ✓ Ensure they read all communications from the school including the weekly Sunflower newsletter

Policy

- ✓ Support the school's policies and guidelines on tackling racist and abusive language, behaviour and bullying.

Curriculum

- ✓ Provide all children with a broad and balanced curriculum and encourage each child to achieve to the best of their ability and develop a love of learning.
- ✓ Inform parent/carers of curriculum coverage each year and set and mark regular homework according to year groups.
- ✓ Inform parents/carers of their child's progress at regular meetings and provide an annual school report.

Safeguarding

- ✓ Provide all children with a safe learning environment.
- ✓ Identify and support children with special educational needs, encouraging each child to achieve
- ✓ Encourage the child to take care of their surroundings and respect others around them.
- ✓ Respect every child's social, religious and ethnic culture.
- ✓ Let parents/ carers know about any concerns or problems that affect their child's work or behaviour.

Support

- ✓ Keep parents/carers informed about school activities through regular letters home, newsletters, and notices about special events.
