**T = Tell**—Tell an adult if someone or something makes you feel worried

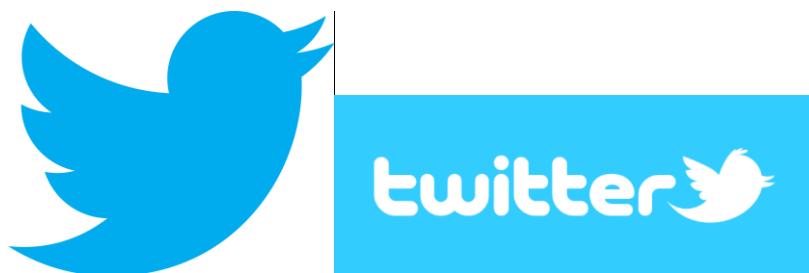
### Spinners
