Cheryl Toolan, our wonderful Treasurer, is stepping down in September and we are urgently seeking a numerate and enthusiastic replacement!

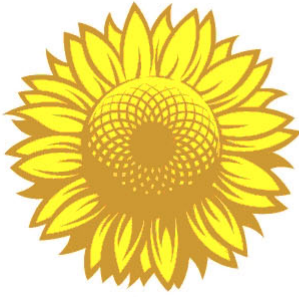
