Car Boot Sale

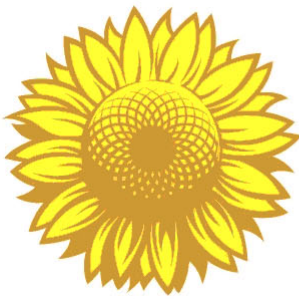
The next Car Boot sale will be on Sunday 29th October, which is the day before the children return from half term.

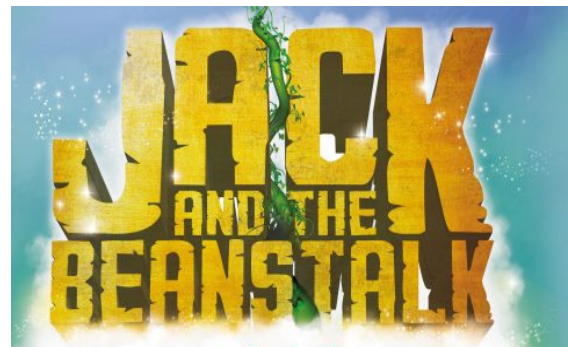

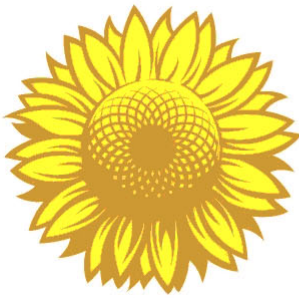
