Christmas Card Project

We are happy to announce the start of our Christmas Card project. This year we are using a new supplier for our Christmas Cards, called "Class Fundraising". For those used to the old system, Class Fundraising runs a similar scheme to our last supplier but with two key differences.

Each drawing or artwork is to be done on a template which is smaller than A4 – there will be a template sent separately by ParentMail or you can pick up spares from the school office or download templates from www.classfundraising.co.uk

Please don't use glitter or shiny paper please as it can upset the scanners and affect the quality cards. Also steer clear of bulky items that won't scan well, but you can use glue to stick on paper shapes, string and other quite flat items. The best results come from felt-tip pen, crayons or paints.

There is also a difference in the ordering process. All the original drawings will be sent to Class Fundraising and they will make example cards for each child so parents/carers can order knowing what the end result will look like. You can order cards, present tags, tea towels mugs and a whole lot more. Many thanks to the teachers who have once again agreed to help us by setting time and resources aside to enable the children to do their designs.

If you would like to create additional designs at home (a maximum of 2 per child please), then just pop them on the supplied template in the SPSA post box outside the office by **12th October** at the latest and we will send them all off to be scanned. Class Fundraising will then produce all the cards and we hope to distribute them in book bags with order forms before half term
