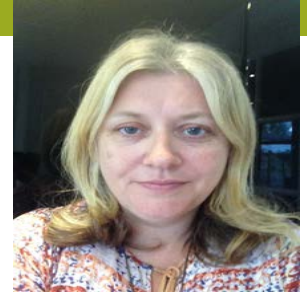
## Car Boot Sale - thanks

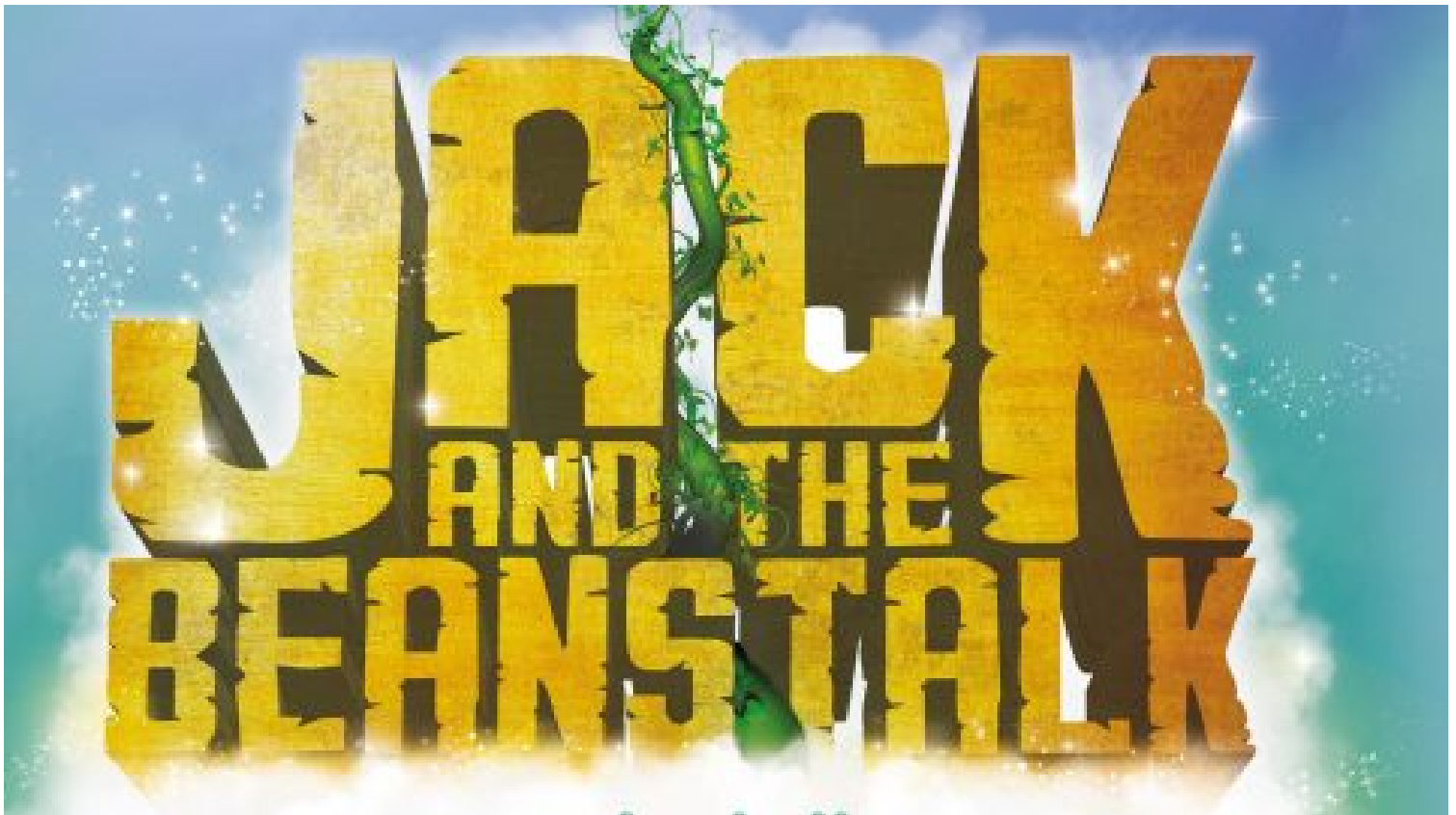

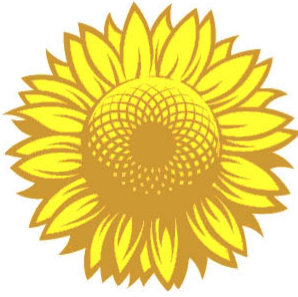
