Unfortunately we won't be able to sell clothing or electrical items.

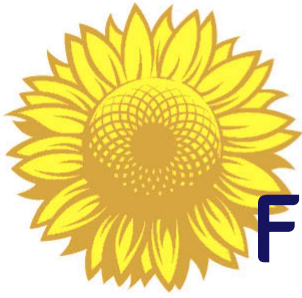
Big Sort Days
