## INTERNATIONAL FOOD EVENING FRIDAY 17<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 6.30-9.30pm

We are now taking bookings for our popular International Food Evening. It's a free event for the whole family celebrating the fantastic diversity at our school. All you need to do is bring some food to share (just enough to feed twice your group) – either savoury or sweet – ideally something that reflects your culture or favourite destination.

We will all eat together at around 7.30pm. It might be best to feed young children at home beforehand.

We are offering a selection of optional activities including sport workshops (provided by Fit for Sport) and dance workshops (provided by Chiswick Theatre Arts). These will take place from 6.45-7.30pm and from 8.15-9.00pm. We are also providing a supervised children's TV / chill out room. The activities are optional but please note that **children must be accompanied by an adult throughout the evening except when they are participating in activities.**

**Entry to the event and to the activities is free.** You just need to bring the food – if you aren't able to cook, please bring something shop bought that is already cooked (and please avoid nuts). You are also welcome to bring your own drinks. There is also a paid bar on the night (including a small selection of beer & wine) and a chance to offer a contribution for the workshops should you so wish.
