Also if your child is sick more than one day you do need to keep us informed. Thank you.

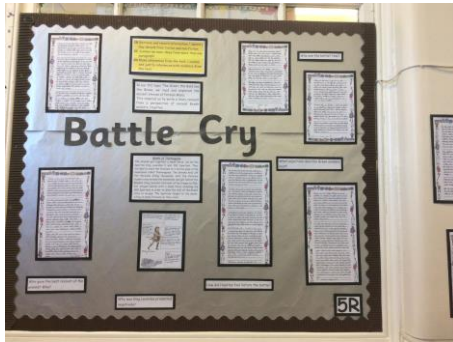


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## Reading across the curriculum and for pleasure

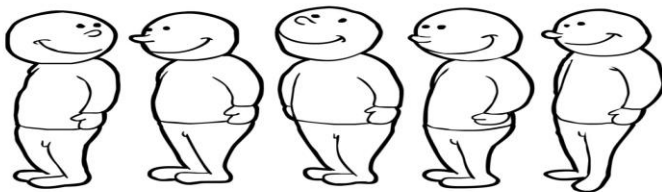
