We have Science club and Violin lessons registration forms for the next term in the school office. We will soon distribute flyers about a new Drama Club, please keep an eye out in your child's book bag.

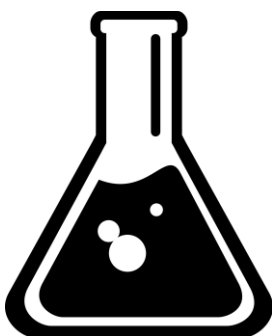
Extra session and concert in the Art Block for the violin students on Monday 6th December.
