School Meals

To the current Y2 parents/carers: Children in Year 3 are no longer entitled to Universal Free School Meals. You need to ensure your child is registered with Harrisons and have credit on their accounts by the beginning of next academic year. If you are receiving benefits such as Income Support or JSA, you could apply on line for Free School Meals. If your child is on the school's Free School Meals List, she/he can receive free school milk, and you may be able to get financial support for after school clubs.

To Year 6 parents/carers: Your child is leaving Southfield this year, please kindly ensure any outstanding debt is paid before the end of July.

Litter

We have noticed that there is quite a lot of litter outside the school gates and in the nearby streets.
